

New photo book on agrarian landscapes in Europe and North America: order now at € 5,- discount!

Agrarian landscapes not only produce food and fibre, but also offer scenic beauty, biodiversity and heritage values. The Dutch Centre for Agriculture and Environment (CLM), together with the US based Institute for Agriculture and Trade Policy (IATP), have compiled a photo book called *Values of Agrarian Landscapes Across Europe and North America*.

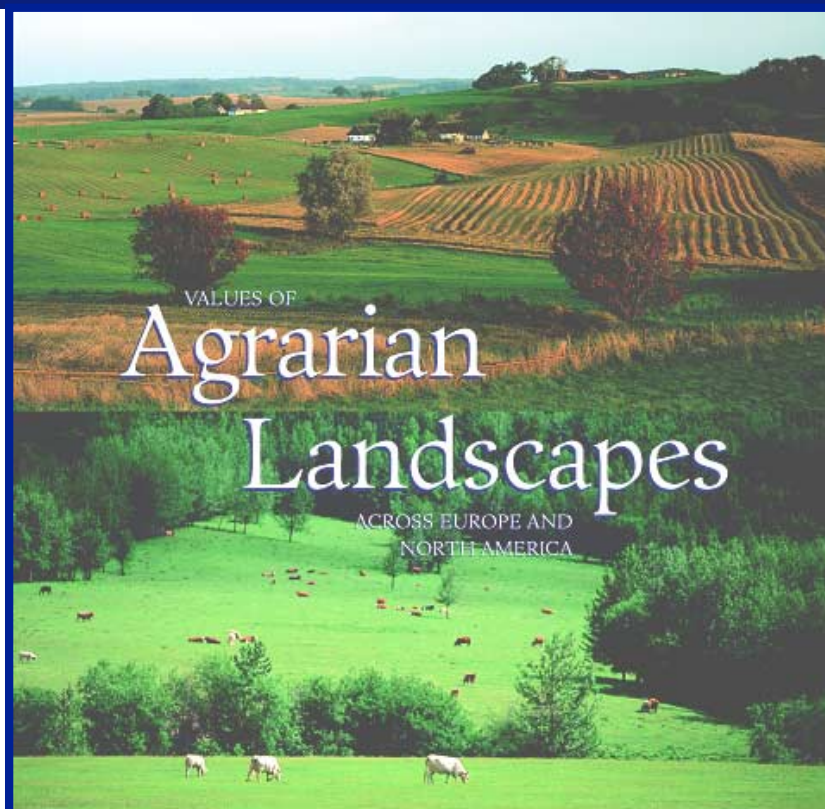
In 144 pages, the book takes the reader from the Dutch peat lowlands to the Polish Biebrza floodplains and the Montana prairie lakes, from the Alps to the New York Catskill mountains, from the Iberian *dehesas* and *montados* to the Arizona Sky Islands and from the Greek Aegean Islands to Hawaii. In addition, the book includes the Mediterranean olive groves and migratory livestock systems, or *transhumance*, in both Europe and the US. The book includes interviews with farmers and conservationists in the regions involved. Besides people, we meet species like the Black Vulture, the Black-tailed Godwit, the Iberian Lynx and the American Blue-winged Teal.

The book explains why these valuable landscapes are vulnerable and endangered if they are left to the market – European and American landscapes alike. For this reason, the book also pays attention to public and private measures and incentives to maintain and strengthen these unique combinations of agriculture, biodiversity and scenic beauty.
